Arborvitae	Pest Prone
Bottle Tree (Brachyciton populnevs)	Allergenic, invasive roots
California Pepper Tree (Schinus Molle)	Height, subject to breakage
Brazilian Pepper Tree (Schinus terebinthifolius)	Height, subject to breakage
Desert Broom (Baccharis sarothroides)	Allergenic, invasive
Elm Species – Except Chinese Evergreen (Ulmus parvifolia)	Breakage and messy
Eucalyptus Species	Height, iron cholerosis, messy
European Olive (olea europea) exception “Swan Hall TM ”	Allergenic, bruiting bodies
Fountain Grass – Except Purple Fountain Grass Pennisetum cupreum and other sterile hybrid	Invasive
Italian Cypress – Natural and cultivars	Height, form, pest prone
Populus species (Poplar, Aspen Cottonwood)	Height, invasive, root rot
Palm Trees – Except Mediterranean Fan Palm (Chamaerops humilus), *Mexican Blue Palm (Brahea Armata) *Pindo Palm (Butea capitata)	Height
Mexican Palo Verde C (Parkinsonia aculeate)	Height, messy, invasive
Mulberry	Allergenic
Pine species – Except Pinon (Pinus Edulis) *Japanese Black Pine (Pinus Thunbergiana)	Height
Sycamore (Platanua wrightii)	Height
Tamarisle (Tamarix aphylla)	Invasive
Weeping Willow (Salix babylonica)	Height, messy
Cow’s Tongue Cactus (opuntia engelmannii –var. Lingui formis)	Pack rats
