San Ignacio Heights HOA Preferential Survey on Roads Funding

The purpose of this survey is to solicit more input regarding the preferences of Homeowners as to how to fund HOA street repair and/or replacement. Any future special assessment will require a formal vote and approval by a majority of Homeowners.

The options listed below are based on the Frank Civil Consulting recommendations and estimates, and on estimates obtained by the Roads Committee. Details are in the Streets Maintenance Plan. This plan has been posted on the HOA website (sanignacioheights.com), distributed by email to Homeowners, hand delivered by Block Captains, and is available in the Ramada.

Rank your preferences from 1 to 6 with 1 being your first choice and 6 being your last choice.
A) The HOA should mill and replace some streets and repair others.
A1) The HOA should seek an upfront assessment of \$6,630 per household
A2) The HOA should seek an assessment of \$7,600, collected over 8 years (\$950/yr.) This assumes the historical rate of inflation of 3.8%.
B) The HOA should mill and replace all streets.
B1) The HOA should seek an upfront assessment of \$9,000 per household
B2) The HOA should seek an upfront assessment of \$9000 (\$3000 collected over 3 years).
B3) The HOA should seek \$1100 per year over 10 years for a total of \$1,789,227 or \$11,250 per homeowner. This assumes the historical rate of inflation of 3.8%.
C) The HOA should do nothing
