

San Ignacio Heights HOA Temporary Parking in Guest Parking Areas (Adopted, January 21, 2026)

Guest Parking areas are intended for temporary use by guests of Homeowners. Upon occasion, homeowners may have a need to park in Guest Parking (e.g., remodeling, houseguests, garage sales, moving in/out). If homeowners or guests need to park in Guest Parking for longer than 72 hours, a Temporary Parking Permit is required.

Application for a Temporary Parking Permit is by email, submitting name, address, phone, license plate#, and expected dates of use, to SIHHOAparking@gmail.com. If approved, a Temporary Parking Permit for display in the vehicle will be returned by email.

Permits will be issued by the Compliance Chair or a designate. Typically, permits will be approved for parking up to two weeks, or, upon rare situations, up to a month. Approvals requesting more than a month require approval by the Board.

If a permit application is rejected, the homeowner may appeal to the Board. The Board's decision is final.

Vehicles parked for longer than 72 hours without a permit will be tagged with a warning notice, stating a date no more than 72 hours ahead by which the vehicle must either be removed or receive a valid Temporary Parking Permit. Vehicles that remain after the warning date will be subject to towing.

Exceptions to this policy for ADA protected reasons will be considered individually. Exceptions will be reported to the Board.
